### Did You Know?

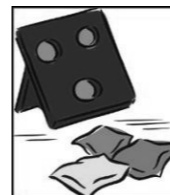
We are now picking up several kids on Sunday evenings in the church van in the Decatur area. Thanks to drivers Mike Huston, Duane Scott, and Josh Souder.
